Thieves steal 11 horses while owners away

THIEVES have stolen 11 horses from a field in Durley, near Winchester. The animals were reported missing at the weekend when the owner of the two-year-old geldings returned home from a fortnight away.

The herd, which is kept in a secure field near the Robin Hood pub in Durley, had reduced from 34 animals to just 23. A search of the local area failed to find any sign of the horses. Police are now investigating, and are searching for criminals in relation to the disappearance, which is being treated as a theft.

Members of the equine community are now warning each other to ensure their animals are kept secure. None of the horses, all of which were coloured except for one grey and one black, were branded or micro-chipped. Anyone with any information about the horses' disappearance should call Hampshire Police on 0845 045 4545, or Crimestoppers anonymously on 0800 555 111.

Horse owner reporting that she has arrived at her field today to find that someone has unscrewed all the bolts from the gate and left it wide open. The gate was found to be open and put on the latch and all the bolts bar one have been unscrewed

Horse owner has two coloured horses in the field and she is aware that there have been recent thefts of such horses. Both horses are still in field and appear aio att

Horse owner is just a little concerned by this as someone has gone to the effort of unscrewing all the bolts and then putting the gate on the latch. Horse owner is going to resecure the gate and will call back if she has any further concerns

Hi,

I live in Welwyn. Last night (8th June) we experienced a strange occurrence at our home stables. My daughter checked the three ponies at 8.30 pm., and decided it was still too warm to close windows etc.

She returned to the stables at 9.30 pm., to find one of our feed rooms had been opened and items belonging to one of our liveries had been tampered with, but more alarming was a head collar and lead rein had been put on one of the ponies. She was still in her stable and we think that our dogs barking may have disturbed whoever was visiting us. We saw nobody enter through our gate and guess that entry was made from the roadside.If we have any further incidents I will keep you informed.

Suspicious Incident

Over the weekend of 8/9 th June 2 Shetlands were taken from there stable in the Bishops' Stortford area, however they were located later on a few miles down the road with over large headcollars on that did not belong to the owners. They were returned safely to there owner unharmed.

The vehicle owner had left the vehicle locked in the car park at the front of the location. The offender approached the vehicle and smashed a side window. A handbag was taken from the front passenger seat.
